ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF

SEMICONDUCTOR EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS INSTITUTE

FIRST: Name. The name of the corporation is  
SEMICONDUCTOR EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS INSTITUTE.

SECOND: Purposes and Powers. The purposes for  
which this corporation is formed are:

(a) The specific and primary purpose is to bring all  
persons connected with the semiconductor industry together  
to exchange ideas and work jointly toward solving common  
technical problems; to the improvement and stabilization  
of standards in the semiconductor industry; to promote and  
stimulate interest in and the demand for products and services  
in general of said semiconductor industry.

(b) The general purposes and powers are to have and  
exercise all rights and powers conferred on nonprofit corpora-  
tions under the laws of California, including the power to  
contract, rent, buy or sell personal or real property. Provided,  
however, that this corporation shall not, except to an insub-  
stantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any  
powers that are not in adherence with the primary purposes of  
this corporation, and provided further that this corporation  
shall not be empowered to conduct or engage in any mercantile,  
commercial or mechanical business.

THIRD: Organization. This corporation is organized pur-  
suant to Part 1 of Division 2 of Title 1 of the Corporations Code of

FOURTH: Principal Office. The County in this state where the principal office for the transaction of business of the corporation is located is Santa Clara County.

FIFTH: Directors. (a) The number of Directors of this corporation shall be seven (7), unless said number shall be changed by duly authorized amendment to these Articles and the By-Laws of the corporation. In no event, however, shall the number of Directors be less than three (3).

(b) The names and addresses of the parties who are to act in the capacity of Directors until the selection of their successors are:

(c) The manner in which Directors shall be chosen and removed from office, their qualifications, powers, duties, compensation, and tenure of office, the manner of filling vacancies on the Board, and the manner of calling and holding meetings of the Board of Directors, shall be as stated in the By-Laws.

(d) Directors shall not be personally liable for the debts, liabilities, or obligations of the corporation.

SIXTH: Members. (a) The authorized number, if any, and qualifications of members of the corporation, the filling of vacancies, the different classes of membership, if any, the property, voting and other rights and privileges of members, and their liability to dues and assessments and the method of collection, and the termination and transfer of membership, shall be as stated in the By-Laws. Provided, however, that if the voting, property and other rights or interests, or any of them, be unequal, the By-Laws shall set forth the rule or rules by which the respective voting, property and other rights or interests of each member or class of members are fixed and determined.

(b) Members of this corporation are not personally liable for the debts, liabilities, or obligations of the corporation.

SEVENTH: Stock Not Authorized. This corporation is not authorized, nor shall it have the power, to issue capital stock.

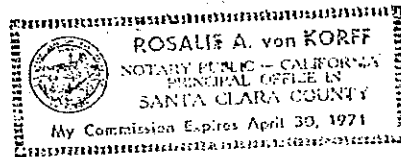
