The ETP provides funding to employers to assist in upgrading the skills of their workers through training that leads to good paying, long-term jobs.

- High Road Training Partnerships (H RTP)

The H RTP program, administered by the California Workforce Development Board (CWDB), supports industry-based, worker-focused training partnerships to build skills for California's 'high-road' employers – firms that compete based on quality of product and service through innovation and investment in human capital, and can thus generate family-supporting jobs where workers have agency and voice.
